Mark has published in the *Association of Professional Genealogists Quarterly*, *National Genealogical Society Quarterly*, the *Genealogical Speakers Guild Speak!*, *The Longhunter* (Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society), the *Middle Tennessee Genealogical Society Quarterly*, and other local society publications. He formerly was the president of the Association of Professional Genealogists (APG), president for the Federation of Genealogical Societies, vice president of the Genealogical Speakers Guild, and president of the Southern Kentucky Genealogical Society. Mark is a Certified Genealogist and a Fellow of the Utah Genealogical Society. He was awarded the Grahame T. Smallwood Jr. award by the APG.
